The District Executive Election Committee (DEEC)- no less than 4 and no more than 7 members

1. The committee chair will be the immediate past District Director
2. Members of the committee shall be:

 - b. Past District Presidents
 - c. Career Advancement Committee Representative
 - d. Early Professional Committee Representative
 - e. SLC – non-voting
3. Final Committee Members (6.20.2022)
 - a. Chair- Mark Coberly
 - b. Voting Members
 - i. Eric McDonnel
 - ii. Lynn Bott
 - iii. Michelle Boyd
 - iv. Kaleb Birney
 - v. Melissa Bulin
 - c. In-the-event-of-a-tie- Rob Marshall (Current District Director)
 - d. Non-Voting- Claire Love

May 11, 2022

1. President will share the proposed timeline with the Board and begin the formation of the DEEC

June 8, 2022

1. District President will announce to the MAATA BOD that the election process for District President is Open
2. DEEC is finalized
3. The following are the qualifications for the position of President. To be considered, candidates for the position must meet these requirements.
 - BOC certified for at least 5 years, member of MAATA
 - Have served as an elected voted Board of Directors member of an NATA District OR;
 - Have served as an elected officer within a state association OR;
 - Have served as the chair for a standing MAATA Committee.
4. Eblast will be developed and sent out the following week notifying the membership that elections will take place in the fall for District President, Secretary and Treasurer
 - a. Call for candidates with timeline, eligibility requirements, and overview of election process

June 30, 2022

1. President reminds Board and Members that there is a call for candidates for District President.

July 11, 2022

1. Candidates for President shall inform the chair of the DEEC of their desire to seek a District Executive office.
 - a. Begin submitting application materials
 - i. Letter of interest
 - ii. Resume/vita
2. Candidates for Secretary and Treasurer shall send application materials to their respective state representative.

July 25, 2022

President

1. Application materials due to Chair of DEEC (Mark Coberly)

Secretary and Treasurer

1. State Representative narrows candidates to 1 for secretary and 1 for treasurer
2. State Representative sends final candidates to DEEC Chair

ALL

3. Chair informs DP of # of applications
4. The DEEC begins to review all candidates.

August 2, 2022

The DEEC will narrow the field of all eligible candidates to two (2) candidates.

August 3, 2022

1. The DEEC will present the candidates' names to the MAATA BOD Executive Committee

August 10, 2022

1. MAATA BOD Call to approve final candidates

August 11, 2022

All finalists are notified by DEEC Chair

September 16, 2022

Candidate video statement, written statement of interest, bio form submitted to DEEC Chair.
DEEC Chair sends info to web czar

September 30, 2022

1. Candidate info posted on website
2. E-Blast about impending election
3. Survey monkey created

October 7, 2022

1. Voting opens

2. E-Blast announcement w/ voting link

October 28, 2022

November 9, 2022
